A Note From Pastor Jim


Matthew 28:19-20

St. John's Lutheran Church Council Meeting April 12, 2011

The regular meeting of the Council held on Tuesday, April 12, 2011 was called to order at 6:05 PM by President Merle Otwell. Members present were Merle Otwell, Jimmie Dale Rader, Leslie Zillig, Lavon Meyer, LaNell Ressmann, Mary Lea Pfenninger, and Harry Heil. (All present) Pastor Benson also attended and gave a short devotion and opened the meeting with a prayer. No congregational members were present.

Old Business

The March Council Minutes were reviewed. Leslie moved and Harry seconded that the minutes be approved. Motion carried.

LaNell gave the treasurer's report. After reviewing by the Council Members, concern over the year to date deficit was discussed. Giving has gone down dramatically. Council discussed waiting until July, which would be half way through the year and would have a better feel for how the budget, if needed, would be revised. Harry moved and Leslie seconded that they be approved as submitted. Motion carried. The financials were posted in the parish hall as was decided last month. The financial report submitted by John Drier was reviewed.

The May calendar was reviewed by all Council members. Additions and corrections were discussed and made as needed.

The mail was reviewed. Only one item needed to be acted upon. Our subscription to the Rotary club for placing a US flag in our yard on appropriate holidays is due. Lavon moved and Jimmie Dale seconded to continue the subscription. Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Property Committee:

Leslie reported that one of the A/C units had been worked on. The bill would be forth coming. Bearings had to be replaced. Leslie also reported that Harry had the trees sprayed. He declined to be reimbursed for the fee. The Council accepted his generous donation and thanked him on behalf of the Congregation. Leslie also reported that we were waiting on the report from the structural engineer on the wall situation.

LaNell reported that the eleven ladies would be attending sharing a meal at LaBahia and then going to the see a play at the Leo J. Welder Center for the Performing Arts.

New Business

Pastor Benson gave the Council a formal letter stating his last day would be May 29th. Pastor also requested that his contract be amended for the month of May. He would like to be in Goliad only two days a week. After discussion Leslie moved and Harry seconded to allow the amendment. Motion carried.

The next vote was set for July 10^{*}th. Bishop Tiemann has been contacted to find a Sunday that he can visit our congregation as prescribed in the exit procedure. Merle will share that information as soon as she hears back from him. Merle is also arranging pastors for the summer months. Congregational members would be asked as well as ordained ministers.

Pastor Benson reported that three transfers were sent to Ander. Mary Lou Fromme and Gayle and Valerie Albrecht have moved their membership. We wish them God's blessings in this move. They will be greatly missed.

With no further business Lavon moved and Jimmie Dale seconded that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting was adjourned at 7:10 with the Lord's Prayer.
